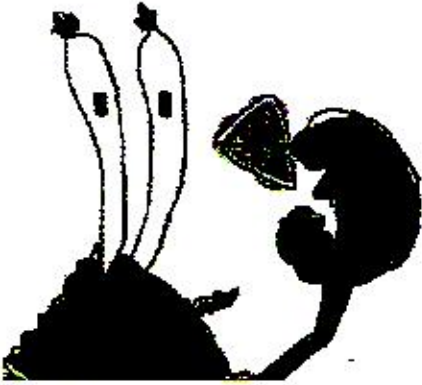

Attendees will be dazzled with tales of lobster sized crawfish, Indian battles, sunken ships and early gold town tales. Those hearty enough for such madness will have a chance to see the largest Myrtle tree in all of Oregon!

The Campsite will be at the Curry County Park aptly named Lobster Creek Camp which is approx 18 miles north east of Gold Beach http://www.co.curry.or.us/departments/parks/lobster_creek_camp.php.

This rustic camp has RV spots and Adirondack style cabins that are on a first come first serve basis. There is no power or water at the campsites or cabins

We have reserved one cabin for those with mobility issues if you need one please let us know ASAP so we can make arrangements. All the cabins have space for up to 6 men but bring your own bedroll and some sort of heater that does not need electricity. The A-Frame has 7 sets of bunk beds for those who can climb the stairs. Bath house has toilets and showers.

Food and Drinks: you are on your own with the exception of the following. The day of the tour, April 18, breakfast of Bryce's famous blueberry pancakes and sausage will be served. Dinner of hamburgers and brats will also be served. Feel free to bring your own dead flesh or other accompaniments.

One of our stops is near the Hunter Creek Tavern which will be around lunch time. I plan to take an hour break if anyone wants to grab some food or they can go somewhere else and meet back up with us.

Friday April 17

6 a.m.: Camp opens, first one up better start the coffee.

Noon: A group will trek up to Cape Blanco to repair our monument.

3 p.m.: Leap frog lessons.

Saturday, April 18

8 a.m. Griddles is on, get your vittles.

9:30 a.m. First stop is at the camp entrance, with two more stops before getting to town.
Hunter Creek Tavern lunch break at 12:30 p.m.

1:30 meet in Gold Beach at Pioneer Cemetery with two more stops on the way back to camp. The last stop for those who want there will be about a half mile hike to the largest myrtle tree.
