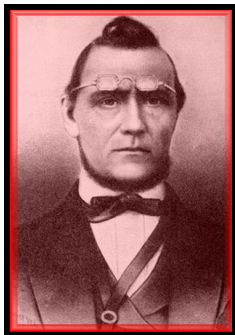

**DOC MAYNARD ANNOUNCES FALL DOINS EVENT:
RETURN TO THE DUCK**

We discussed returning to the rock, the buck, and the beach. This year we have decided to return to Orondo River Campground for our Fall Doins event...affectionately dubbed the Return to the Duck! With overwhelming support from those in attendance at our first Spring Doins we have successfully negotiated our return to this beautiful riverfront venue.

Jeffrey "Quackers" the Duck was made an honorary member of the Irish Kate Brigade of Spokane County at our Spring Doins event. After spending a weekend with him we have deemed him worthy of joining us as a prospective PBC candidate for Doc Maynard. Because he is bound to his owners and cannot leave Orondo we have decided as a whole to bring our Fall event to him.

The 2017 Fall Doins will take place at Orondo River Park, just 10 miles from the geographic center of Washington State. With an average historic temperature of right around 80 degrees, plenty of shade, and a nice cool river to douse your unmentionables when necessary this is a perfect location for late summer clamping!

13 RV sites are available on a first come, first serve basis and there is ample space for tents. Bathrooms with hot showers (a quarter is worth more than a 10 minute hot shower!) are available as well as the primitive and expected honey buckets.

Friday night our Washington outpost hopefuls (Irish Kate and Robert Gray) will be providing food with a suggested donation of \$5 to help maintain their coffers. Entertainment, while unpaid and likely hard to stomach, will be provided as well.

Saturday at 8am any PBC candidates will begin their due process. There will be no restrictions to PBC use and abuse at this event with the exception of Grand Council regulations.

We will be holding our traditional Apple Pie contest as well as a well stocked and appealing raffle. There will be a shirt of the day and pin for the event as well as a hawker booth set up all day on Saturday. All official chapter hawkers from other chapters are welcome and encouraged to attend.

Bring all the fool's gold you can muster! Your rub will include our world famous slippery (Friday from 6pm to 10pm, Saturday from 9am to 11pm, Sunday depending on the condition of the libationist), three meals Saturday and a continental breakfast Sunday (meals will include dead flesh, starches, and other necessary additions), as well as the ground space for you to lay your head.
